Acceptable Items For Disposal

- Nearly all damaged/unwanted herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, rodenticides and wood preservatives.
- Pesticides such as Diazinon, Atrazine, 2,4-D, Captan, Dursban, Malathion, Parathion, Toxaphene, Chlordane, Heptachlor, Silvex, Lindane, 2,4,5-T, Penta, etc.
- Other ag. chemicals including animal medications, solvents, paint additives, rodent baits, degreasers, lead-based paints, etc.



Hazardous materials safely disposed.

NO COST for the following Milwaukee County businesses to dispose of agricultural chemicals:

- Farms & abandoned farms
- Nurseries
- Greenhouses
- Orchards

Unacceptable Items

- Empty chemical containers
- Infectious or biological waste
- Compressed gas or cylinders
- Explosive, radioactive waste, freon
- Tires, batteries, waste oil, latex paint

Unknown Ag. Chemicals

- Unknowns will be accepted in quantities less than 5 gallons or 50 lbs. Special terms available to collect larger amounts.
