Dates: September 25-27

Times: 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Place: SE corner of Boerner Botanical Gardens parking lot, 9400 Boerner Drive, Hales Corners, WI 53130

What's recyclable: #2, #5 and #6 pots, polystyrene cell packs and trays, black plastic edging

What to do first: Please knock out all dirt and debris from materials before bringing them to Boerner. If possible, sort and stack by pot size and number.
