I CAN SEE THE MOON!

Children as young as three will enjoy becoming astronauts and flying to the moon in this new, active Starlab program. Children will participate in activities, song, and see the night sky full of stars in the Starlab.

BLAST OFF TO MARS

Children take a trip to Mars as kid astronauts to learn about its features and what astronauts need to live there.

Earth's Moon, its visible features, formation, the Apollo landings, activities to learn the moon's phases and why they occur are all a part of this program.

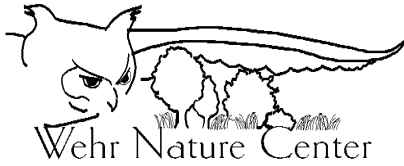
SUN SECRETS

STARLAB FOR SCHOOL GROUPS

Starlab is a portable, inflatable planetarium available year round for astronomy programs. Programs are available at Wehr Nature Center (WNC) or at your school with Nature in the Parks (NIP).

WNC PROGRAM FEES

\$3.25/Student

\$2.25/Student (Milwaukee County residents)

A minimum group fee of \$45.00 required.

STARLAB FEE

\$25.00 (in addition to the fee per student) is required for Starlab programs.

IN-SCHOOL (NIP) PROGRAM FEES

\$200 for half a school day (3 1-hour programs)

\$400 for a whole school day (6 1-hour programs)

No charge for naturalist lunch time

Limit of 25 children per program (1 hour)

ROOM REQUIREMENTS

Rooms must be at least 25' X 25' with a 13' unobstructed ceiling.

Rooms must be on ground level or with elevators and have the ability to control lights and sound.
