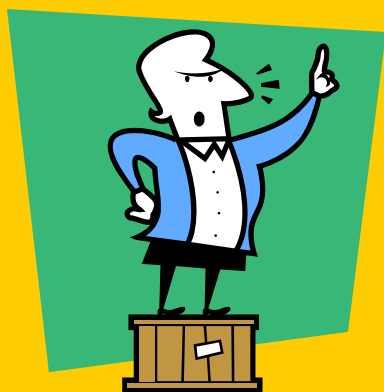

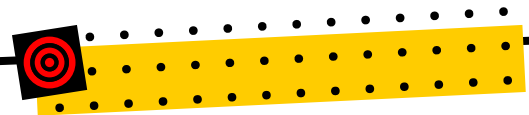

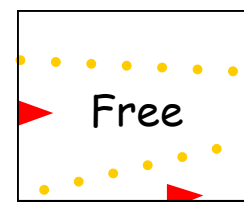

What is the Mini-Society Teacher Workshop about?

The Mini-Society Teacher Workshop is a “train-the-trainer”

Experiential-based instructional system targeted primarily for teaching entrepreneurship, economics and citizenship concepts to children ages eight to twelve years.



In Mini Society, children develop a self-organizing economic society with the consultative guidance of the teacher. The program is driven by the need to resolve a classroom situation involving the fundamental economic problem of scarcity and its alternative solutions. As the system swings into action, the spontaneous interactive learning experiences of the children are woven into an instructional fabric that emphasizes learning in entrepreneurship, economic and the social science.

Educators will learn how to further promote motivation and encouragement independence, creativity, and self-directed learning by the children with guidance by the educator.



Qualifications:

This is a two part workshop. In order to receive all incentives participant must be present for the entire sessions. The first session involves a full days of training in the curriculum. The second session, will engage participants in the hands-on practical experience of Mini Society. A follow-up session will be held two months following the training as a “booster” session where you will present the work. While attending this session you will receive support and feedback from the trainers.
